## 12 Days of Christmas – Day 3 Small Gift Bag made from ½ Sheet Designer Paper!



## **Supply List:**

Stamp: Tidings & Trimmings

Ink: Early Espresso Cardstock/Paper:

Painted Christmas Designer Paper 12 x 12
Basic White scrap – die cut scallop rectangle
Embellishments: Early Espresso Faux Suede

Trim Ribbon, Linen Thread or Twine **Tools:** Tear & Tape (or strong adhesive), Scalloped Contour Dies, ½" hole punch, bone

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Place 12 x 12 Designer Paper in trimmer, gently score at 5¼ and 6¾.

  Notes: Designer Paper is thinner than cardstock, so gently score so as not to tear paper.

  If Designer Paper has directional print, have direction run horizontally when placed in trimmer.
- 2. Rotate paper once and cut at 6" to create 2 pieces (you will make 2 bags from one sheet)
- 3. On short side of 6 x 12 piece, score at 1½ and 4½.
- 4. Crease all score lines with bone folder.
- 5. Trim 2 middle score lines on each long side just up to lengthwise score line, creating a tabs.
- 6. Place Tear & Tape on each tab on the right side of the paper.
- 7. Place Tear & Tape on the wrong side of the paper on the outer segments of one side of bag.
- 8. Remove Tear & Tape backing from tabs and fold up towards side of bag without Tear & Tape.
- 9. Remove Tear & Tape from remaining side of bag and fold up on bag.
- 10. Use bone folder inside of bag to press and seal bag sides.
- 11. Pinch top of bag and punch holes on each side.
- 12. String about 15" of Early Espresso ribbon through holes of bag and tie a bow in the front.
- 13. Using Scalloped Contour Dies, cut small scalloped rectangle from Basic White scrap.
- 14. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp sentiment on small scalloped rectangle.
- 15. String Linen Thread through one of the holes on scalloped rectangle, then under Early Espresso ribbon on bag and tie in bow.
