## 12 Days of Christmas – Day 1 Note Card Gift Card Holder



## **Supply List:**

Stamp: Frosted Gingerbread

Ink: Real Red Cardstock/Paper:

Basic White Note Card & Envelope

Gingerbread & Peppermint DSP; 31/4 x 43/4,

1½ x 5, 2 x 5¼ Old Olive ¾ x 4¾

Scrap Basic White – punched 1¾ circle

Scrap Real Red – punched shape

**Embellishments:** Basic or Red Rhinestones,

Real Red Sheer Ribbon (8")

**Tools:** Seal Adhesive, Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue, Tear & Tape, Dimensionals, Label Me Lovely Punch, 1¾ circle punch, Sharpie Marker

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Fold note card base in half and crease on score line using bone folder
- 2. Adhere ¾ x 4¾ strip of Old Olive across center 3¼ x 4¾ DSP piece.
- 3. Tie a knot towards one end of Real Red Ribbon using Sharpie Technique.
- 4. Wrap ribbon around layered DSP piece with knot towards right side centering on Old Olive strip. Tack down in back.
- 5. Adhere Layered DSP with ribbon to front of note card.
- 6. Stamp sentiment on 13/4 Basic White circle using Real Red ink.
- 7. Punch a Label Me Lovely shape from the Real Red scrap.
- 8. Adhere stamped sentiment circle to real red punched shape.
- 9. Adhere layered shapes to front of note card using dimensionals.
- 10. Decorate front of card using Rhinestones.
- 11. Using 1\% circle punch, punch a small sliver in center of top edge of the 1\% x 5 piece of DSP.
- 12. Use Tear & Tape on the sides and bottom edge of 1½ x 5 piece of DSP and adhere to inside of card to create a pocket for your gift card.
- 13. Using liquid glue, adhere 2 x 51/4 strip of DSP to outside of the envelope flap, trim edges.
