12 Days of Christmas – Day 7 *Evergreen Elegance Card*



Supply List:

Stamp: Evergreen Elegance

Ink: Real Red, Old Olive

Cardstock/Paper:

Old Olive card base 5½ x 8½, scored at 4¼

Basic White cardstock: mat 4 x 5¼, 3 x 3½,
and a ¾ x 4¼ strip

Real Red 3¼ x 3¾

Embellishments: Basic Rhinestones, Small
metal star, Wink of Stella Glitter Brush

Tools: Seal Adhesive, paper snips, bone
folder, dimensionals

Instructions:

1. Fold card base in half and crease on score line using bone folder.
2. Using Old Olive ink, stamp trees across bottom of card front. Create different shades of the ink by 'stamping off' some of the ink.
3. Stamp 3 trees on 3 x 3½ piece of Basic White. Using the same 'stamping off' technique to make the trees on the left and right a lighter shade of Old Olive ink.
4. Use Wink of Stella Glitter Brush to add some shimmer to the trees on both the card base and the Basic White piece.
5. Lightly tap your Wink of Stella Brush against your bone folder to splatter some of the glitter onto the background above the trees of both the card base and the Basic White piece.
6. Adhere Basic White piece to Real Red piece and mount on card base using dimensionals.
7. Stamp sentiment on Basic White strip using Real Red Ink, trim ends at an angle then adhere to card using dimensionals.
8. Stamp inside mat with sentiment and additional trees if desired, then adhere to inside of card.
9. Adhere metallic star to top of center tree.
10. Add a few rhinestones to front of card.
