"H-Fold" Fun Fold Card

Card Stock base $4\frac{1}{4} \times 11$ scored at $5\frac{1}{2}$

White or Vanilla mat $4 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$

For Sentiment/Image White or Vanilla $2 \times 3\frac{1}{4}$

Designer Paper 2 of the same design $1\frac{1}{4} \times 4$

2nd color of Cardstock $2\frac{1}{4} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

Stamps: Sentiment and Image to fit on $2 \times 3\frac{1}{4}$ piece, along with Ink for both
Adhesive; Seal, Seal+, Tear & Tape, or Liquid Glue
Embellishments; ribbon, twine, rhinestones, etc.

Basic Instructions:

Place card base in trimmer length wise, line up the score line at $1\frac{1}{2}$, and cut, set aside larger card base piece.

From the remaining piece, cut a $1\frac{1}{2}$ strip to make a $1\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{4}$ piece, set aside.

From what's remaining again, turn lengthwise and cut at $3\frac{3}{4}$, you will end up with a $2\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$ piece.

Crease card base on score line. Adhere Designer Paper to the $1\frac{1}{2}$ section.

Adhere 2nd piece of Designer Paper to the $1\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{4}$ strip of cardstock.

Position layered card stock strip on end of card base opposite $1\frac{1}{2}$ section of base, line up edges but do not adhere.

Put adhesive on two short edges of the $2\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$ piece of cardstock and lay across card catching the two $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch sections/layers. When card is opened, you'll have created an 'H' shape as the card front.

Stamp sentiment/images on $2 \times 3\frac{1}{4}$ piece of White or Vanilla. Adhere to 2nd color of cardstock then adhere to front of card.

If desired, stamp or embellish edges of White or Vanilla mat before adhering it to inside of card.
